

**OPEN ENROLLMENT PROCEDURE 2 – TUITION – NON-RESIDENT PUPILS**

The official residence of a child is that of his parents or legal guardian. A child under 18 years of age may not claim residency by living with any relative other than a parent or with any other person, unless such relative or other person is a legal guardian.

Students whose parents or legal guardians do not reside within the boundaries of Mountain Home School District No. 193 may be required to pay a tuition charge for attendance for this school district. If a student is staying with someone other than a parent(s), an affidavit of legal guardianship shall be filed at the time of enrollment in the office of the Superintendent.

Mountain Home School District No. 193 reserves the right to deny or accept attendance of a non-resident student based upon Idaho Code 33-1404.

Mountain Home School District No. 193 may require a signed Agreement to Pay Tuition prior to admission, acceptance for all non-resident students.
