

**PEST MANAGEMENT POLICY**

3 Structural and landscape pests can pose significant problems for people and property. Pesticides  
4 can pose risks to people, property, and the environment. It is therefore the policy of the Mountain  
5 Home School District to incorporate Integrated Pest Management (IPM) procedures for control of  
6 structural and landscape pests. The objective of this program is to provide necessary pest control  
7 while minimizing pesticide and herbicide use. As an integral component of this policy, the  
8 Mountain Home School District adopts the EPA: IPM for Schools Manual and the University of  
9 Wisconsin’s IPM Manual as our pest management plan. An IPM coordinator will be appointed by  
10 the superintendent, or designee. The IPM coordinator will establish specific pest thresholds and  
11 pest control methods for all school district facilities and procedures for reporting, public  
12 notification, record keeping, and pesticide use and selection.
