Category 1 :. Low Community

Spread: Evidence of isolated cases or limited transmission, case investigations underway, no evidence of exposure in a large communal setting. E.g. healthcare facility, school, mass gatherings

Traditional Learning

All students attend school Monday - Friday.

There are some added protocols to protect students from possible exposure to Covid-19

Category 2: Minimal to Moderate Community

Transmission: Widespread and/or substantial transmission with high likelihood of confirmed exposure within communal settings, with potential for rapid increase in suspected cases.

Blended Model, students attend school 2 days and online 3 days. Students with last names:

A - L: Attend school Mondays and Wednesdays. Online Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays.

M - Z: Attend school Tuesdays and Thursdays. Online Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

Category 3: Extensive Community Spread:

Learning: Large scale community transmission, healthcare staffing significantly impacted, multiple cases within communal settings like healthcare facilities, schools and mass gatherings.

School Closures: All students attend online only.

Arriving Before School

Category 1: Traditional Learning:

Students are required to:

- Follow all rules and guidelines for physical distancing.
- Wait outside or head to the Commons for breakfast.
- Wash hands or use an approved hand sanitizer.
- Wear a mask in the building
- Have all needed materials in a backpack

Students are discouraged from:

- Come to school if feeling ill or have a fever.
- Using hallway lockers

Category 2: Blended Learning:

Students are required to:

- Go immediately to their first period class or determined place to wait for permission to proceed to their first period class.
- Have all needed materials in a backpack.
- Wash hands or use an approved hand sanitizer
- Wear a mask in the building.

Students are discouraged from:

- Come to school if feeling ill or have a fever.
- Using hallway lockers

For those who walk or arrive at school by some other form of transportation, please do not arrive any earlier than 7:30 am.

Category 3: School is Closed

Transportation will not be provided.

MHJH Re-entry Plan

Classroom Expectations

Category 1: Traditional Learning:

All students attending Monday - Friday.

Students are required to:

- Maintain physical distancing
- Wash/disinfect hands
- To wear a mask
- Clean/disinfect work stations frequently
- Bring a backpack with all needed materials

Students are discouraged from:

- Attending school if feeling ill or having a fever.
- Share materials with other students.
- Using their lockers

Category 2: Blended Learning:

Half of the student body is attending face to face; the other half online.

Students are required to:

- Attend face to face or online school on assigned days
- Maintain physical distancing
- Wash / disinfect hands
- Clean / disinfect work stations
- Wear a mask
- Bring a backpack with all needed materials
- Follow routes designated in the classroom.

Students are discouraged from:

- Attending school if feeling ill or have a fever
- Sharing materials with other students
- Congregating in groups

Category 3: Online Learning:

All students are online.

All students are required to log in and attend all classes at assigned times.

This schedule will be followed when school is operating in **Category 1** and in **Category 2** when students are attending school on their assigned days.

In Category 2 (yellow), students will attend face to face on the following days:

Students **A-L**, Mon & Wed. (Tues. & Thurs. students attend their classes at the same times online)

Students **M-Z**, Tues & Thurs. (Mon. & Wed. students attend their classes at the same times online)

Friday - Online only for all students.

Hallway Expectations

Category 1: Traditional Learning:

Students are required to:

- Follow all standard rules and procedures.
- Maintain physical distancing
- Follow designated paths in hallways and stairs.
- Wash and/or disinfect hands

Students are discouraged from:

- Congregating in large groups
- Using their lockers

Category 2: Blended Learning:

Students are required to:

- Follow all standard rules and procedures.
- Maintain a physical distancing
- Wash and/or disinfect hands
- Wear a mask
- Follow designated paths in hallways and stairs.

(Class periods may be staggered to decrease congestion in hallways during passing times)

Students are discouraged from:

- Gathering in groups
- Using their lockers
- Using water fountains

Category 3: Online Learning

All students are online.

MHJH Re-entry Plan

Breakfast / Lunch

Category 1: Traditional Learning:

Students are required to:

- Follow all standard procedures and protocols.
- Wash and/or disinfect hands before eating.
- Maintain distances between other students
- Use other designated areas for eating to promote physical distancing

Students are discouraged from:

- Sharing food/drink with other students

Category 2: Blended Learning:

Pre-plated and/or pre-packaged food meals:

Students are required to:

- Follow all standard procedures and protocols.
- Wash and/or disinfect hands before eating.
- Maintain physical distancing
- Use other designated areas for eating to promote physical distancing
- Lunch times may be staggered to decrease congestion in the commons or lunches may be brought to classrooms where their lunches will be eaten.

Students are discouraged from:

- Sharing food/drink with other students.

Category 3: Online Learning:

Designated areas may be available for food distribution.

Details will be made available via social media.

Recess

Category 1: Traditional Learning:

Students are required to:

Adhere to standard procedures and protocols for outside activity.

Refrain from gathering in large groups.

Category 2: Blended Learning:

Students are required to:

Adhere to standard procedures and protocols for outside activity.

Maintain physical distancing among peers.

Students may be assigned to certain areas of the playground.

Wear mask if required outside

Category 3: Online Learning:

Campus is closed.

MHJH Re-entry Plan

After School / Transportation

Category 1: Traditional Learning:

Students are required to:

- Go directly to their bus or where their ride is waiting for them.
- Those who are waiting for their bus to arrive may do so in designated areas.
- Leave campus immediately after school if they walk home.
- Wear mask when riding the bus

Students are discouraged from:

- Loitering
- Gathering in large groups

Category 2: Blended Learning:

Students are required to:

- Go directly to their bus or where their ride is waiting for them.
- Wait in assigned designated areas for their bus to arrive.
- Leave campus immediately after school if they walk home.
- Wear a mask while riding the bus

Students are discouraged from:

- Loitering
- Gathering in large groups

Category 3: Online Learning:

Re-entry Plan

Category 1: Traditional Learning

Games and practices will be held as normal.

Athletes may be required to wear a mask while traveling or when not competing.

Spectators may be limited or restricted.

If spectators are allowed to attend an event, they may be required to wear a mask.

Category 2: Blended Learning:

Practices and / or games may be limited or suspended.

Spectators will be restricted from all events.

Category 3: Online Learning

All games and events are cancelled.
