

Welcome Back – the following policies/procedures/non-policy procedures/forms may be reviewed/revised/adopted/deleted during this school year and can be found on the district website under Departments>Policies & Procedures>Policy Review.

Only those policies that are being adopted, deleted, or revised will go before the Board for three readings. Policies that are being reviewed with no changes, or being deleted, or are considered an emergency, or as directed by state and federal laws, will go before the Board for one reading only. The exception is the Continuous Improvement Policy, which goes before the board for one reading only. Non-policy Procedures are approved by the Policy Committee and not by the Board.

The policy list is not in any particular order, but just a list of the policies in cycle for the 2019-20 school year.
