

The Policy Committee will have its first meeting October 13 – 3: 30 p.m. – DO Conference Room – the following policies/procedures/non-policy procedures/forms may be reviewed/revised/adopted/deleted during this school year and can be found on the district website under Departments>Policies & Procedures>Policy Review.

Only those policies in cycle that are being adopted, deleted, or revised will go before the Board for three readings. Policies that are being reviewed with no changes, or being deleted, or are considered an emergency, or as directed by state and federal laws, will go before the Board for one reading only. The exception is the Continuous Improvement Policy, which goes before the board for one reading only. Non-policy Procedures are approved by the Policy Committee and not by the Board.

The policy list is not in any particular order, it is just a list of the policies in cycle for the 2020-21 school year.

The Policy Committee Meeting schedule is on the districtwide calendar, which is found on both the building webpage and the district webpage, generally the second Tuesday of each month. The schedule may change at any time. The first scheduled Policy Committee Meeting is October 13, 2020, at 3:30 p.m., in the District Office Conference Room.
