NOTICE OF FEE INCREASE

The Mountain Home School District No. 193, Elmore County, is required to increase the student meal fee for all the schools in Mountain Home School District due to the Healthy Hunger Free Kids Act of 2010, as required by Federal Law, Public Law 111-296. School Lunches will increase every year until we meet the Federal Healthy Hunger Free Kids Act of 2010. Mountain Home School District No. 193, Elmore County, has also proposed to increase student activity and elective fees at Mountain Home High School, Mountain Home Junior High, and Hacker Middle School.
